

Group Rates and Licensing for *The Mystery of History*

Are you a co-op, tutorial, collaborative, hybrid school, or private school? No matter what you call your group, we're eager to help you add *The Mystery of History* to your classroom with group-rate pricing and licensing. Groups of six families or more are eligible for a **30% discount** from retail prices on select products through the author (The Mystery of History, Inc.) or the publisher (Bright Ideas Press), depending on the size and scope of your order.

To determine eligibility for a group rate, and whom to contact, we've provided a PDF of common scenarios with a check mark indicating which company can best meet your needs in each situation. But, before you dive into the details, the following information might be helpful:

- **The Mystery of History, Inc.**, the family-owned business of the author (and owner of this website), is in the **retail business** and offers discounts for **small group orders** (not shipping to the same address) and classroom licensing on select items.
- **Bright Ideas Press**, the publisher of *The Mystery of History*, is in the **wholesale business** and offers discounts for **bulk orders** and **school orders** (shipping to a single address) and classroom licensing on applicable items.

Now, let's look at who is eligible for a group rate and whom to contact through the common scenarios listed below. If you have a unique situation, please reach out to either company for a free consultation.

Eligibility for a Group Rate or Licensing	Contact	
Volumes of <i>The Mystery of History</i>	MOH	BIP
A group of 6 or more families is interested in discounted volumes of <i>The Mystery of History</i> where the group is invoiced as a <i>single unit</i> and the books are shipped to <i>one address</i> .		√
A group of 6 or more families is interested in discounted volumes of <i>The Mystery of History</i> where each family <i>pays separately</i> (using a coupon code), and books (and/or other materials) are <i>shipped or emailed to individual families</i> .	√	
A group of 6 or more families meeting 1-3 days a week wants to purchase a bulk order (as a single unit) for the purpose of keeping the books and “loaning” them to families on an annual basis. (<i>Companion Guide</i> codes, found in the inside cover of our volumes, fall under a single-family license. Therefore “used” volumes of <i>The Mystery of History</i> require classroom licensing of the <i>Companion Guide</i> for repetitive use. See more on <i>Companion Guide</i> licensing below.)		√
Any group of six or more families that meets 5 times a week is considered a “ school ” and is subject to Bright Ideas Press for group rates on <i>The Mystery of History</i> and proper classroom licensing.		√

<p>A group of 6 or more families wants a classroom license for our <i>Companion Guides</i> because:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) the books are owned by the school and the licenses have been “used” in the first year of ownership. To clarify: the first year a group of any size buys books to keep, that group is free and clear to use the <i>Companion Guide</i> codes in every book purchased for students—and classroom licensing is <i>not</i> required. 2) a teacher of any sized group makes copies of select pages in the <i>Companion Guide</i> for students who do not own a <i>Companion Guide</i>. To clarify: If students in a classroom of any size have each purchased their own <i>Student Reader</i> containing a digital <i>Companion Guide</i> code, a classroom license is <i>not</i> required by the teacher to make copies to use in the classroom for convenience. 		√
